2009 YEAR END NEWSLETTER

The Miss Annie wrapped up 2009 successfully with additional tournament wins, a dramatic increase in charter business and a lot of fun by all up and down the East Coast and in the Bahamas. We took 1st Place finishes in the 2009 Buccaneer Cup Sailfish Tournament and the 2009 Fish For Life Sailfish Tournament out of our home port of Sailfish Marina on Singer Island, Florida in January. We finished 2nd in the 2009 HMY Megadock Tournament in July in Charleston, South Carolina, and the Sailfish Slam in October. We took 4th place out of 298 boats in the 2009 White Marlin Open out of Ocean City, Maryland in August.

Over the past three years of tournament fishing, The Miss Annie has finished 1st five times in Florida and the Bahamas, 2nd four times in Charleston, the Bahamas and Cape May, New Jersey, 3rd place twice in the Bahamas and the MidAtlantic 500 in Cape May and a 4th place finish in Ocean City, Maryland in the White Marlin Open. The Miss Annie set a new tournament record for the 2009 Fish For Life Sailfish Tournament by releasing 42 sailfish in two days out of Sailfish Marina. If you would like to charter the Miss Annie for a tournament, let us know.

Our charter activity increased dramatically in 2009 despite the economy and continues strong into 2010 with bookings into April and May out of Sailfish Marina on Singer Island, Florida. The charters can be for up to six people for a half day, ¾ day or a full day to catch sailfish, kingfish, dolphin, shark, bottom fish, etc. Family trips are welcome; the kids will have a ball! Everything is included except live bait and your choice of lunch. Multi-day charters are also available, including to the Bahamas. We also offer corporate packages for those of you who would like to promote your business or professional relationships by enjoying a day or more aboard a first class sport fishing boat.

The Miss Annie is a 52 foot Viking sportfishing machine. Outfitted with all state-of-the-art electronics, custom tackle, and professional crew, we will put you on the fish. From all pelagic species such as Sailfish, Blue Marlin, White Marlin, Yellowfin Tuna, Bluefin Tuna, Swordfish, Shark, Mahi Mahi, Wahoo to all others including Mutton Snapper, Yellowtail Snapper, Grouper, Amberjack and Cobia, the Miss Annie will keep you in the action.
